Struktura 2025 is organized again in South Bohemia but for the first time in Jindřichův Hradec. After two years it includes sessions on neutron scattering, that were prepared by recently established Czech Neutron Association. We can welcome guests from three European facilities. In addition, there are three short courses - again on the Mstruct software for fitting of some parameters of real structure; for biocrystallographers - Moorhen - web based application that brings the power of the COOT model-building software to the browser; and *mace-md-gui* that run basic molecular dynamic/static simulations in an interactive interface with a machine learning MACE MP interatomic potential. Nearly 70 registered participants are also invited to the excursion in museum of old American cars and brewery in Nová Bystřice, followed by raut in questhouse in Číměř that is owned by our former colleague - Anita Župčanová.
